2. Pet Shop Introduction	Owning a pet requires responsibility and commitment Needs and wants of humans and pets. How they are similar/different	 What is responsibility? What is commitment? What is a need? What is a want? What are needs of humans and pets? 	Class Discussion (10 mins)	• 1 Flip-chart	10 mins
3. Group Activity - Pet Shop	To understand how to purchase a pet and what is required to care for a pet	Students will divide into groups (6 total works best) Part 1 - Each group will be given a "child profile" and will have to match the profile to the appropriate pet Part 2 - Each group will then have to shop for their pet based on its specific needs Groups present their pet and answer Pet Secret Situation Cards	Group Work — Matching (10 mins), Pet Shop (20 mins)	1 piece of paper/group Markers Pencils/pens Bristol board Tape/sticky tack	30 mins
