












ACAF program

ACAF National examination key features

- Exam eligibility: successful completion of entry, technical, and applied ACAF courses. Apply within two years of ACAF program completion technical and ACAF electives not older than ten years.
- Duration: four hours
- Format: multiple choice and written response to case-based questions
- Re-write: three attempts
- Transition: Students who complete ACAF's Business Applications course before December 2017 are exempt from the ACAF National Examination
