

Purpose

The CPAEF Education Foundation has established a bursary award to honour Mr. David Sale, FCPA, FCGA, a former board chair of the legacy CGA-BC Association and co-chair of the CPABC Joint Venture, in memory of his tremendous contribution to academia and the accounting profession.

The David Sale FCPA FCGA Bursary assists accounting students attending a BC post-secondary institution who have demonstrated financial need with bursaries of up to \$3,000 per annum.

Procedures

This form should be completed and submitted with a **recent transcript of marks** and a **covering letter** to the CPA Education Foundation of BC. The covering letter should explain your reason for requesting financial assistance, including any extenuating short- or long- term circumstances, and your career goals.

We are currently developing a more streamlined submission process. In the interim please follow the steps outlined below.

Step 1

Save and name all your application documents, i.e. this application form and any required supporting documents, in the following format:
