

Why train a CPA student?

Grow the talent you need in your organization.

To earn a CPA designation, CPA students must complete:

- the CPA Professional Education Program, typically spanning a period of 2.5 years (part-time study)
- 30 months of relevant accounting work experience (practical experience requirements)
- successfully pass the three-day Common Final Exam (CFE)

CPA students cultivate essential accounting, finance, and management skills to effectively support organizational needs.

To ensure the CPA student's practical experience requirements are met, students and employers have the following responsibilities:

Candidate's responsibilities

- Develop competencies in accordance with the core, depth, breadth, and progression requirements
- ✓ Discuss competencies with the assistance of a CPA mentor
- Report practical experience

Employer's involvement

- Offer a professional accounting position to a future CPA
- ✓ Properly supervise the employee
- Over 30 months, assign tasks of increasing complexity, requiring higher levels of autonomy

Two Experience Routes, One Designation.

Pre-Approved Program Route (PPR)

In PPR, CPA candidates are employed by organizations with training programs that have been pre-approved by the CPA profession.

Experience Verification Route (EVR)


Using the EVR path, candidates work at an employer of their choice and submit their relevant experience for evaluation directly to CPABC.
