- *difficulty requesting their international school to mail multiple official sealed education documents to more than one Canadian company address. For applicants who have an international degree and have not completed any accounting related courses, CPAWSB recommends you request a WES Basic Degree Report. However, if you have completed an international degree with a major in accounting related courses, CPABC recommends you request a WES International Credential Advantage Package (ICAP) Degree Report.*
