

Summary of Amendments to Bylaw Regulations, Bylaws and the Code of Professional Conduct from March 2018 to August 2018

Yukon Bylaw Regulations

MARCH 2018

Part 2-CPA Yukon Board, General Meetings and Officers and Part 3-Committees Board Meeting Procedures 209/3(2) and Committee Procedures 308/5 authorize the board and committees to meet in the absence of the public.

Part 5 Membership

Deadlines for Legacy Applicants 501/2(b)(i) and (ii) extended the deadline for legacy applicants to meet the practical experience requirements to June 30, 2020 under certain conditions

Part 6 Continuing Professional Development

Continuing Professional Development: Basic Requirements 600/2 (1) “Basic Requirements” has been added and “Regulation” has been replaced with “section”.

Continuing Professional Development Program: Post-Admission Requirement for Foreign Qualified Legacy CA Members 600/3 (1), (2), (3) were added to identify additional post admission requirements and possible exemptions.

Continuing Professional Development Program: Post-Admission Requirement for Legacy CGA Members 600/4 (1), (2), (3) were added to identify additional post-admission requirements and possible exemptions.

Annual Compliance Report 600/5 has been changed from 600/3 to 600/5.

Part 7-Licensure for Public Practice

Proof of Professional Liability Insurance Coverage 704/3(1) The word “registration” has been replaced with the word “issuance”.

Appointment of Assisting Accountant 704/4(1) The word “registration” has been replaced with the word “issuance”.

Part 11 Investigations

Bylaw 1108 Publication

(Housekeeping amendment to Bylaw 1100)

Public transparency of regulatory activities is important in ensuring public trust in a professional regulatory body. It has been determined that redacted Determination & Recommendations (“D&R”) should ordinarily be published on the CPAY public website as opposed to the members’ only website.

On March 22, 2018 the Board also approved the following amendment to the bylaw regulations for immediate effect:

Part 5 Membership

Bylaw 505 Fellows

A national report on Member Recognition Programs suggested that it would be appropriate to restrict the number of repeat nominations or to remove an awarded fellowship in certain circumstances. This amendment to Bylaw 505 allows for the revocation of a member’s fellowship in appropriate circumstances specified in the Bylaw Regulations.

On March 22, 2018, the board also approved the following amendment to the bylaw regulations, to come into effect on the same day as the foregoing amendments to the bylaws:

Election of Fellows 505/1

CPABC Code of Professional Conduct

Housekeeping Amendment 201.2 –The housekeeping amendment to the Code of Professional Conduct deletes an unnecessary reference and is not considered substantive.
